How We May Use and Disclose Your PHI

We may use or disclose your PHI for:

- Treatment

- Health oversight activities
- Judicial and administrative proceedings
- Law enforcement purposes when authorized
- Organ and tissue donation
- Workers' compensation
- Serious threats to health or safety
- Other uses permitted or required by law

Other uses, including most marketing communications or disclosures not otherwise permitted, require your written authorization.

Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Inspect and obtain copies of your medical records.
- Request corrections to your medical records.
- Request confidential communications.
- Request restrictions on certain disclosures.
- Receive an accounting of disclosures.
- Obtain a paper copy of this Notice.
- Revoke an authorization previously provided, where permitted.
